From NYC: Take Saw Mill River Pkwy to Taconic Pkwy North, Exit TSP onto Route 55 East (Exit 47A). Continue on 55 East through 4 lights (12mi), take second left after 4th light onto Old Rt. 55, at the bottom of a large hill. Turn left onto Penny Rd, Club is 1.25 miles up road

From I-684: Take 684 to North End (Exit 9), 684 becomes Rt 22. Take Rt 22 North 12 Mi, then turn left onto E. Main St. Go 1.4 Mi (at clock tower), then slight left onto Old Rt 55 West. Take approx. 2 miles to Penny Rd, make right, club is 1.25 miles up road.
